

Admission Requirements

Spanish degree

To be considered an eligible candidate in good standing for admission to a graduate programme, you must hold a bachelor's degree or comparable:

- A university degree equivalent to an EHEA undergraduate qualification (minimum 180 ECTS credits), or
- A bachelor, associate or engineering degree awarded prior to the implementation of the EHEA (minimum 3 academic years)

Documents you must submit on paper:

- Copy of your DNI.
- Certified copy of your university degree or receipt of degree awarded. It can be a photocopy with an original stamp.

You can do the admission online and provide this documentation scanned. If you obtain admission and enrol, you will need to send your certified documents by post or to come in person with the certified documentation.

European degree

To be considered an eligible candidate in good standing for admission to a graduate programme, you must hold a bachelor's degree or comparable:

- An EHEA undergraduate degree (minimum 180 ECTS credits), or
- A degree equivalent to a Spanish bachelor, associate or engineering degree earned prior to the implementation of the EHEA (minimum 3 academic years)

Documents you must submit on paper:

- Copy of your DNI or passport. If you are a foreign student, you must submit a copy of your TIE (Tarjeta de Identidad del Extranjero, Foreigner's Identity Card). If you have not obtained it yet by the time of registration, please submit it as soon as you get it.
- Certified copy of your official university degree, issued by the competent authorities. It can be a photocopy with an original stamp.
- Certified copy of your official transcript, issued by the competent authorities, listing the period in academic years, subjects taken, credits earned and grades obtained. It can be a photocopy with an original stamp.
- All documentation issued in Catalan, Spanish or English is accepted. In all other cases, it is necessary to attach the translation into Catalan, Spanish or English, made by a legal translator, or by a diplomatic or consular representative of the Spanish State abroad, or by the diplomatic or consular representative in Spain of the country which the applicant is a national.

Non-european degree

To be considered an eligible candidate in good standing for admission to a graduate programme, you must hold a bachelor's degree or comparable:

- A university degree equivalent to an EHEA undergraduate qualification (minimum 180 ECTS credits/3 academic years)

Documents you must submit on paper:

- Copy of your DNI or passport. If you are a foreign student, you must submit a copy of your TIE (Tarjeta de Identidad del Extranjero → Identity Card of the Stranger). If you have not obtained it yet by the time of registration, please submit it as soon as you get it.
- Certified copy of your official duly validated university degree, issued by the competent authorities. It can be a photocopy with an original stamp.
- Certified copy of your official duly validated transcript, issued by the competent authorities, listing the period in academic years, subjects taken, credits earned and grades obtained. It can be a photocopy with an original stamp.
- All documentation issued in Catalan, Spanish or English is accepted. In all other cases, it is necessary to attach the translation into Catalan, Spanish or English, made by a legal translator, or by a diplomatic or consular representative of the Spanish State abroad, or by the diplomatic or consular representative in Spain of the country which the applicant is a national.
- You can do the admission online and provide this documentation scanned. If you obtain admission and enrol, you will need to send your certified documents by post or to come in person with the certified documentation.

More information about validating academic documents:

Legalization is the process by which documents issued outside of Spain become officially recognized. It is based on agreements between Spain and the issuing countries:

Countries where the directives for degree recognition of the Council of the European Union are applicable:

Germany, Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, The Netherlands, Hungary, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Norway, Poland, Portugal, United Kingdom, Czech Republic, Sweden and Switzerland by bilateral agreement with the EU.

If your degree is from any of the countries above, you do not need to legalize it.

Countries who have signed The Hague Convention Agreement of October 5, 1961:

The first point applies to countries listed below and which are EU members.

To legalize documents from these countries, the Apostille issued by the competent authorities is required.

Other countries not included in these first two categories:

The degree must be legalized by diplomatic means. It must be submitted to:

1. The Ministry of Education in the country where the degree has been issued
2. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country issuing the degree
3. The Spanish diplomatic representatives in that country (embassy, consulate, etc.)

Documents issued by diplomatic or consular authorities of other countries in Spain must be legalized by the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Official Translation

No translation is necessary for documents submitted in Catalan, Spanish and English. Documents in other languages must be submitted together with their Spanish or English translation by:

- Spanish diplomatic or consular representatives abroad.
- Diplomatic or consular representatives in Spain of the country where the student is a citizen or where the degree has been issued, as the case may be.
- Legal translator duly registered or authorized in Spain.

Pending degree

If you still do not have your university degree (or comparable) but you plan to **obtain it before the beginning of the postgraduate**, you can apply online now and submit your degree title during the enrolment.

In order to do so, you will have to complete and sign the **Enrolment request without university title**. During the enrolment you will need to send your certified degree by post or to come in person with it.

In case you fail to submit the degree title (prior to the start of the programme) you will still be able to enrol in the graduate diploma, but at the end of it you will be entitled to a certificate of achievement, not a title.

Please be reminded: you must **submit the degree title** or proof of payment **before the start of the programme**.
